




Make a Brush in Photoshop

My granddaughters love splattering paint around, so I have them splash different paint blobs on paper (set up outside) I then photograph the different paint splashes.

1. Open the brush splatter image
2. We need to resize the image as the maximum size image for a brush is 2500 px square.
3. Click >Image>Image Size in the dialog box type 2500 in the height dimension. Click OK





4. Select the Magic Wand  and click on the grey background.

5. We have now selected the pixels we want to paint white. Select White  as your brush colour and paint over the image with the paint brush.

6. Select >Edit>Define Brush Preset.

7. Name your Brush Splatter.



8. Open a new document (Select International Paper A4) select your brush (Open the brushes options  and select your brush), choose a colour and click on your document. In the video I will show you how to change some of the brush settings.
